Explain how your organization is involved in creating a safe, healthy and drug-free community:

The Coalition organizes and oversees its work through different workgroups that help to accomplish the goals outlined in our strategic plan. Work groups typically meet once a month and sometimes quarterly, depending on the status of their work.

- **Membership**- The primary focus of this group is to develop & implement a recruitment plan in order to ensure that all 12 sectors & diverse populations of the community are represented on the coalition. Monthly meetings are held the last Friday of every month with a feature presentation.
- **Communications/Media**- This group's goal is to create and implement social marketing campaigns that target specific groups to change social norms, such as targeting adults who provide alcohol to minors. This group will also assist with promoting community programs, special events, and services.
- **Policy Change**- This group's goal is to work towards identifying policies and/or practices that negatively impact youth and families, such as youth getting alcohol from adults and local retailers, and then looking at how to implement change.
- **Adolescent Health Taskforce**- This group's goal is to look out for the physical and mental well-being of youth in Morgan County. This group collaborates with other local agencies and community members to offer programs and support to assist in the development of positive assets.
- **Substance Use Prevention Taskforce**- The primary focus of this group is educating the community on the dangers of substance use; including alcohol, marijuana, methamphetamine, fentanyl, and other dangerous substances. This group assists with compliance checks, SADD (Students Against Destructive Decisions) and other events to support the youth in making healthy and responsible choices.
